- Do they have a fever?
- Do they have a rash?
- Are they coughing?

If you have answered yes to any of these questions, please keep them home.

It is also Nottinghill policy that if your child is congested, their nose must be running clear for them to attend school.

We will be calling parents to come pick up any child who comes to school ill.

This keeps the teachers and other children healthy and our school open!
