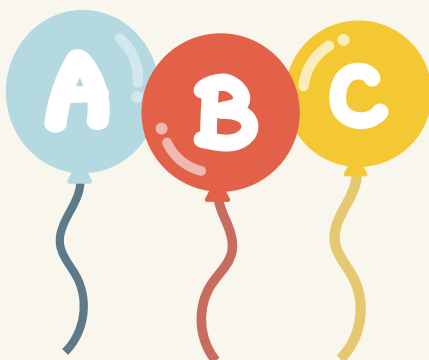
A big thank you to Cristina, our VP Special Events, for organizing!
